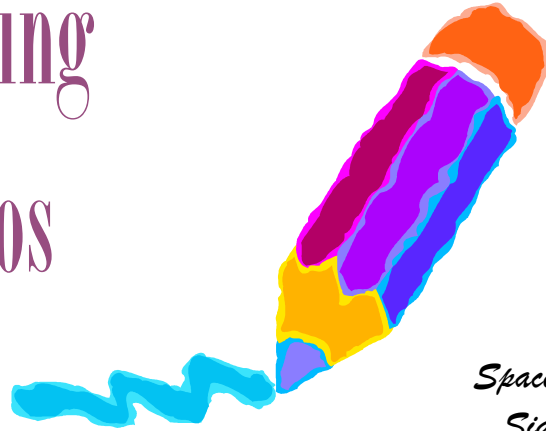

Supplies for Class

(available at Town Hall Arts)

- Pencils grades B to 8B
- Retractable utility knife
- Tablet of good quality (100% rag) drawing paper at least 16x20 inches
- Metal ruler at least 18 inches long
- Compass with center knob to control aperture
- Roll of blue ¾" masking tape
- At least 20 Q-tips
- At least 10 cotton balls
- Two blending stumps—a thin one and a thick one
- A drawing board larger than your drawing tablet
- 8x11 paper to be used as a shield
- A .05 mm mechanical pencil with B-grade lead
- Magic Rub eraser
- A ¼" pencil-type eraser
- A 1/8" Tuff Stuff retractable eraser
- A sheet of medium grade sandpaper
- An empty envelope to collect graphite
